A 27-Year Relationship with Family House:

Liliane's Story



In April 1998, Liliane Johnson made a risky trip from Morgantown, WV to Pittsburgh with a failing heart and little hope of survival. She received a new heart—but was told her chances of living beyond six months were slim. After surgery, she recovered at Family House Neville, arriving in the back of a U-Haul with a 600-pound heart machine she called "Big Mama." It was meant to be her final move.

"It was a surreal moment," Liliane remembers. "But the staff at Family House welcomed me with open arms and a lot of support. It was truly a miracle to receive so much love from strangers."

Despite the machine's size, staff built a custom ramp to ensure a smooth arrival—just one example of the thoughtful care she received. In the days that followed, Liliane found healing in life's simple pleasures: reading in the library, exercising in the quiet fitness room, and sitting on the porch with family. She especially loved the living room piano, which reminded her of her father's classical music.

Over the next 25 years, Liliane stayed at every Family House location, including the recently consolidated location in the Shadyside neighborhood. Through ongoing treatments at UPMC Presbyterian, Montefiore, and Magee-Womens Hospital, she has always returned to Family House.

"I have the support of the entire staff every time I roll in and out of here," she shared during her April 2025 visit.

For Liliane, Family House has never been just a place to stay—it has been a refuge. Her story reflects that of so many others: a journey of healing, connection, and care within a place that truly feels like home.

Keeping Family House Affordable

Through our Family Assistance Program—budgeted at \$360,000 for fiscal year 2025—we help cover room costs and provide essentials like meals, toiletries, and transportation. For guests who qualify, we provide options to discount room rates even further. We recently increased our Medicaid housing discount to \$50 per night.
